FOR CLASSES IX AND X

"The bigger the challenges, the bigger the opportunity for growth." Believe it or not, but it's true. The school has been on a lockdown mode for the last 5 months and yet it has operated seamlessly in the "New Normal" era. The advent of e- learning platforms has made the transition from physical to digital possible and helped us deal with the formidable challenge of the pandemic pre- emptively.

Here's a glance at the historic events organized, festivals celebrated and outstanding achievements in this period.

The class XII CBSE Board Results stands testimony to the quality education being provided in the school. I would like to share with you the highlights of the result. The QPI is 83.8% i.e. 2% higher than last year. 84 students i.e. 32.18% of students have secured 90% and above. 216 students i.e. 82.75% of students have secured distinctions in all five subjects. Ishita Saraogi our Commerce topper has secured 98.60%. Shreya Yadav & Gautam Jaju our Science toppers have secured 96.60% and our Humanities topper Manav Gudwani has secured 97.20%. Gautam Jaju & Ansh Jain have secured highest PCM i.e. 96.67%. The highest PCC is 96.33% secured by Mohammad Sameer Akhtar & Ansh Jain. The highest PCB is 95.67% secured by Aashi Gupta. Our Vocational Topper is Akaash Nandwani with 92.80%. 100 marks have been secured by Gautam Jaju, Ishita Sarogi & Aryan Gupta in Maths and by 10 students in Fine Arts.

The class X CBSE Board Result has been equally stimulating. The QPI secured is 79.41%. 78 students i.e. 20.68% of students have secured 90% and above. 55 students i.e. 14.58% students have secured distinctions in all 5 subjects. Ansh Trivedi is the topper with 97.20% followed by Asmita Jain & Ayush Jindal with 96.60% and Ridhima Goel with 95.80%. 5 students have attained a stupendous 100 in Maths and 18 students have secured 100 in IT.

The school found place in the Top Schools of Delhi 2020 Survey by Careers 360 after a much researched and comprehensive study of schools in the capital. The school achieved BEST RATING on the basis of different parameters like academic reputation, competence of faculty, infrastructure provision, strong alumni, parental involvement and leadership quality.

The school organized its annual event, CROSSROADS 2020, an array of Interschool Competitions, initiated online this year. The event drew an overwhelming response and around 1100 students from 63 schools participated in the 15 subject related competitions.

It has also organized Kreativ 2020, online Interschool German Competitions, in collaboration with Goethe institute, Max Mueller Bhavan. 83schools from all over India have participated in the grand event.

The annual extravaganza, EXPO 2020, for classes VII to X, commenced from 25 August onwards for classes VII to X on a virtual platform. A kaleidoscope of talent, creativity, innovation and knowledge, EXPO 2020, will this year focus on rising above the Covid-19 debacle and helping students become drivers of change.

The school has successfully organized celebration of Independence Day, Janamashtami, DAVMUN, Praestantia, Cyber Week, Career Counseling sessions, Meet my Mentor activity, Yoga Divas, Rotary Installation Ceremony, Thalassemia awareness talk, retirement Ceremonies besides a host of other activities. It has conducted unit tests, held PTM's, all on a digital platform.

It is a matter of great gratification that the unprecedented lockdown of schools has not disrupted either the teaching and learning process or in any way posed a threat to any school activity. The contribution of all stakeholders- staff, parents and students is indeed appreciable and sets an inspiring example of teamwork and resilience.

Amongst the notable achievements, Sipul Pandey of class VII, Cambridge wing secured second position in under junior category in S & T Home Contest- Chromatography video organized by National Science Center.

The Wise Foundation in collaboration with Techfest 2019-20 conducted the WISE International Environment Olympiad 2019. Aadya Joshi of class 5 received cash prize of Rs 10,000/- for being national topper. 9 school toppers received book vouchers worth Rs 1000/- each.

- Writing time – 8.30 a.m. to 11.00 a.m.
- Submission Time – 11.00 a.m. to 11.15 a.m. (for English, Hindi, Maths papers)
And 11.00 a.m. – 11.30 a.m. (for Science and Social Science only)

15 Minute Break 11.15 a.m. = 11.30 a.m. (for English, Hindi, Maths only)
11.30 a.m. – 11.45 a.m. (for Science and Social Science only)

7- It is mandatory for all students to appear in the exams. In case of any problem, they may immediately contact class teacher.


8- If the answer sheet is not uploaded in time, the exam shall stand cancelled.
