Dear Parents,

2020 has indeed been an unprecedented year posing unimaginable challenges at every step of the day. Schools have been no exception. And yet, it is commendable that parents, students and teachers have faced the corona ordeal with amazing courage and outstanding determination. I am confident that students of class X will, with sincere hard work, perseverance, commitment and confidence, excel in the class X Pre-Board Examination to commence from 4.1.2021. Date-sheet will be shared with the students. Kindly note the following points in this regard.

- a. Extra classes are being conducted in the Zero period for different subjects. Special timetable has been framed for the same. Kindly ensure that your ward attends them.
- b. Extra classes are being conducted on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. for the benefit of students to solve their academic problems.
- c. Two Revision Tests of 80 marks each will be conducted as follows:
  - Test I will be **Subjective** pen and paper test based on CBSE pattern to give written practice to students.
  - Test II will be **Objective**, to test the application skills of the students and prevent unfair practices. It will be conducted in the last week of January.
  - The average of the two tests will be taken for Stream Allotment as per the criteria set by the school.
- d. In case CBSE postpones the Board Exams and time permits, another exam (Online/Offline) will be conducted. Please note that this will be subject to the prevailing conditions.
- e. Stream allocation will be done on the basis of performance of the students in the Revision Tests
- f. **There will be no change in the stream allotted even after declaration of CBSE Results.**


