**CLASS V TO VII**

The academic session 2018-19 comes to a close. The school has witnessed spectacular growth and maintains its position among the top most schools. The school bagged 5<sup>th</sup> Rank in North Leaders Category of Times school survey 2018 conducted by The Times of India. It has also been bestowed the Top CBSE School Award in the field of Education and Awareness Campaigns in the North School Merit Award Survey 2018 conducted by Education Today.

A number of major events have marked the school calendar. These include EXPO 2018, Britannica Quiz, Sambhaav, Career Fair, Triumph and others. The session has also marked the inauguration of Atal Tinkering Laboratory and accreditation with Cambridge Assessment International Education Programme.

This festival showcased DAV as a phenomenal organization with renowned alumni making their mark in all fields. 
